Dear Valued Customer,

We have received many inquiries concerning Section 1502 – Conflict Minerals of the Dodd-Frank Act. The rule, mandated by the Dodd-Frank Act, requires public companies to disclose whether they use conflict minerals (tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold) and whether the minerals originated in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries (covered countries). The rule addresses concerns that conflict minerals mined in covered countries help finance armed groups that are responsible for violence in those countries.

Over the past several months we have asked our keys suppliers of aluminum, ductile iron, electronics, motors and plating services to confirm through their supply chains that the materials they provide to Vector Engineering Co. do not contain any conflict minerals. We have received their assurances that the products and services they provide do not use conflict minerals. As a company Vector does not directly purchase or process any conflict minerals. As a result of these investigations and to the best of our knowledge, Vector Engineering does not use any conflict minerals in any of the products we produce.
